#### THE FIRST MUSTANG SOLD

April 15, 1964, two days before the official Ford Mustang on-sale date, one mistakenly left the dealership. The lucky new owner, the first person to buy a Mustang, was Gail Wise, a 22 year old school teacher from Chicago. Her parents lent her the money after she landed her new job but had no way to get to and from the school she was to teach at. Cash in hand, she headed to a local dealership in search of a convertible. When she expressed her desires, she was disheartened to learn no drop tops were in stock. Perhaps seeing her dismay, the salesman told her he had a special surprise and led her to a backroom. Not sketchy at all...

Much to her relief she found a baby blue Ford Mustang convertible. The car had yet to be released to the public, and the salesman knew the sale shouldn't occur... yet. But what's a couple days? Gail offered to pay full price for the car, \$3,447.50, without even taking it for a test drive. No salesman can say no to that.




